

Jason Ellis to challenge Sheriff Harder in 2018 Rep. Primary

BINGHAMTON, N.Y. - A former member of Sheriff Dave Harder's command team is planning to challenge him in a Republican primary next year.

Jason Ellis plans to officially announce his candidacy for Broome County Sheriff during an event scheduled for November 18 at the Sons of Italy Lodge in Endicott.

Ellis began at the Sheriff's Department in 1986 and rose the ranks to hold a number of positions during his 20 plus years there.

He currently is lead investigator for District Attorney Steve Cornwell.

Harder had said following his last election in 2014 that this term would be his last, but he now says he plans to make his intentions known in the near future.
